The Alaska Avalanche Information Center, in an effort to train snowmobile riders for safe mountain travel and recreation and reduce the number of unintentional injuries and deaths in Alaska due to avalanches, proposes to conduct five nationally certified Snowmobile Level I courses in Alaska for the communities of Anchorage, Cordova, Hatcher's Pass, Haines and Valdez. This (AIARE Level 1) course is a three-day intensive training program recognized and certified by the American Avalanche Association and the American Institute for Avalanche Research and Education. Participants of the course will be required to register in advance (space is limited) and pay a nominal fee for attendance. Every effort will be made to accommodate as many interested riders as possible with this program. All proceeds raised will be used to advance snowmobile safety in Alaska. Funds from this grant will be used to hire a nationally certified snowmobile safety instructor to tour Alaska and lead these courses.
